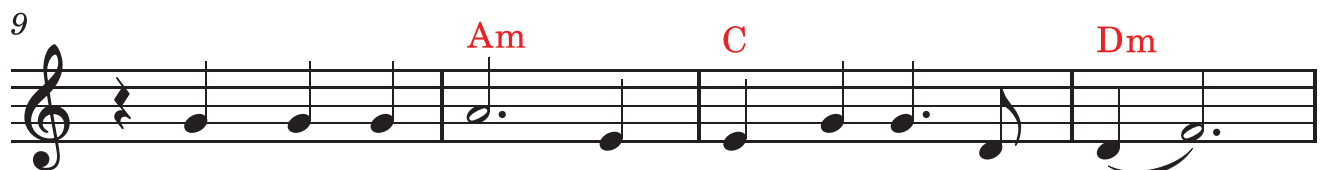
# Be Still, My Soul



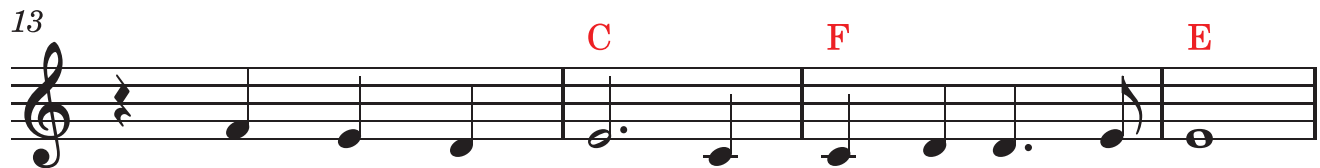
Be still, my soul! the Lord is on thy side;

Be still, my soul! the hour is has - t'ning on\_\_



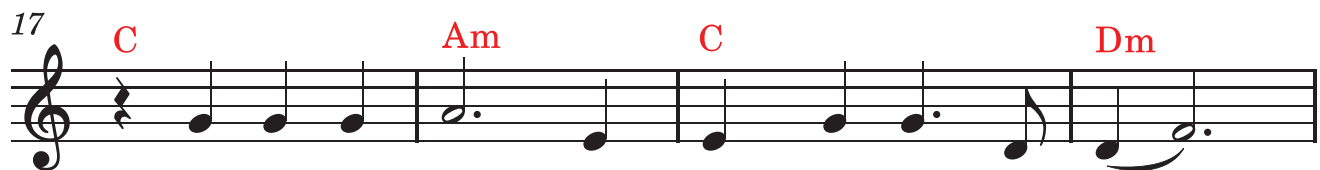
Bear pat - ient - ly the cross of grief or pain.

When we shall be for - ev - er with the Lord;



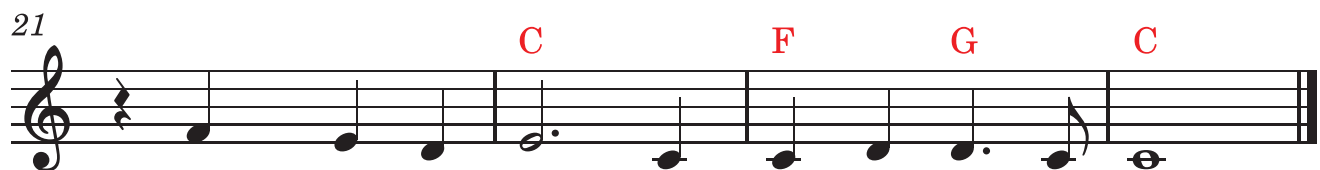
Leave to thy God to or - der and pro - vide;
